4. Consent to Receive Communications

5. Data Protection and Privacy

Your personal data will be processed in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). ESTD ensures appropriate security measures are in place to protect your data and will not share it with unauthorized third parties.

6. Notice Regarding Recording of the Webinar

By registering for and participating in this webinar, you acknowledge and agree that the event will be recorded. The recording may subsequently be made available to ESTD members through our website.

If you choose to participate with your camera enabled and/or ask questions during the session, your image, voice, and contributions may appear in the recording. Please consider this in advance before enabling your camera or microphone.

By registering, attending, and actively participating in the webinar (including with camera or microphone enabled), you consent to the recording and later distribution of the session as described above.

6a. Prohibition on Recording and Distribution

Webinar content is protected by copyright and is intended solely for the personal participation of registered attendees.

Participants are strictly prohibited from recording, photographing, screen-capturing, reproducing, downloading, storing, sharing, distributing, publishing, transmitting, or otherwise making available any part of the webinar, whether in audio, video, image, or other format, without the prior written consent of ESTD.

This prohibition applies to all forms of recording and reproduction, including recordings made for personal use. Unauthorized recording, copying, or distribution of webinar content may result in exclusion from the event and may give rise to legal action.

8. Data Retention
